

HAJJ VISA REQUIREMENTS

1- Passport

If you are a United States Citizen:



- ✚ Original Passport valid for at least six months from the travelling date
- ✚ Minimum of two blank pages to place the visa
- ✚ Must be machine -readable.

If you are not a United States Citizen



- ✚ Original Green Card or
- ✚ a copy of advanced parole, or
- ✚ One of the following valid visa endorsed on your passport: A1, A2, TN, J, H1B, H-3, H-4, L-1, F-1, J-1, M-1 and R-1.

2- Photos




- ✚ 2 recent passport-size color photographs with white background.
- ✚ The photograph must be a full-face view where the visa applicant is facing the camera directly .
- ✚ Side or angled views are not acceptable.
- ✚ Your name should be written on the back of the photographs.

3-Visa Application

- ✚ One Visa Application Form per person.
- ✚ Form should be filled-out in INK or printed and signed



4- Proof of Relationship



All women & children require Proof of Relationship with their Mahram (Marriage certificate for married couples and Birth Certificate for children under 18 years' age, indicating names of both parents). Please provide legible copy of the document(s) and keep the original(s) with you. Minors (under 18 years of age) traveling with one parent must also submit a notarized letter of authorization signed by both parents or legal guardians

5-Proof of Meningitis Shot



- ✚ Original proof of vaccination certificate against Meningitis (one dose of ACYW-135 vaccine) for traveling individuals.

6- SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS



- ✚ If you do not have a Muslim name, a certificate is required from the Imam of your Masjid indicating that you are a Muslim.

7- Unaccompanied Female Travelers



For women traveling alone in a group, the following is required:

- ✚ Must be 45 years of age or older. Or
- ✚ Must provide a NOTARIZED letter from her Mahram indicating that he has no objection for her to travel for Hajj with Dar El-Eiman Travel. Or
- ✚ Proof of Relationship document required showing relationship of the woman to the Mahram(A Mahram is a Husband, Father, Brother, Son, Uncle, Grandfather (Brother or son must be 18 years of age or older)
